"Past, present and future of Radio Science"

The 29th URSI Benelux Forum is offering a meeting opportunity to researchers preparing a PhD in the different scientific fields covered by [URSI \(International Union of Radio Science - Union Radioscientifique Internationale\)](#). Researchers with a PhD are also welcome to present significant advances in their (postdoctoral) research. The meeting offers them and the academic and scientific staff of universities and institutes a unique opportunity to be informed about the different research programmes in Radio Science.

Student Paper Competition

URSI has a clear intention to support Young Scientists through its YS Programme and through supporting and organising Student Paper Competitions at National or Regional events as will be the case at the Benelux Forum 2022. This year three Student Paper prizes will be awarded, €400, €200 and €100.

Organisation

The structure of the Forum will consist of Poster Sessions with contributions from all fields covered by every of the [10 URSI Commissions](#) in addition to a plenary program around the theme "**Past, present and future of Radio Science**", highlighting the centennial of URSI and pitches by eminent researchers on ongoing developments and the future of Radio Science.

An area of 1m (wide) x 2m (high) will be available for all selected posters.

Proceedings

The proceedings of the URSI Forum will consist of a collection of the submitted abstracts and summaries and will be distributed on a USB stick at the Forum to all participants and will be made freely available through the URSI website for a wider distribution in the weeks following the Forum.

A fixed registration fee for all on-site participants and authors is set at € 60,- per person to cover expenses (proceedings, lunch, coffee breaks and reception). A reduced fee of € 30,- is available for online participation in the plenary part of the program.
